
VARIOUS DEPARTMENTAL PROGRAMMES:

1. STUDENT SEMINARS:

Student's seminars are held in the department every year on a regular basis for encouraging and grooming students, keeping in mind their future progress. Normally the department selects a topic and students are given the freedom to decide the areas and themes on which they want to deliver lectures. The faculty members are always available to groom them for the said presentation. About 6 to 8 students are selected by the department for the final presentation. A judge, either from outside the college or from a different department, is selected for judging their presentation. Normally 3 prizes are given to the students as tokens of appreciation and encouragement.

On 10th. May 2022 such a seminar was held to commemorate Satyajit Ray's Birth Centenary. 8 students presented their paper on this occasion



Another webinar was held on June 5th 2024 to commemorate bicentenary of Michael Madhusudan Dutta. 6 students presented their paper on various aspects of Madhusdan Dutta's literary activities.





2. WORKSHOP ON CCF HELD ON 28TH JULY 2023.

When The University of Calcutta changed the old Syllabus and pattern of teaching and introduced the new CCF syllabus from the academic year 2018-19, the Bengali Department of the College along with the University of Calcutta Bengali Board of Studies jointly organized a Workshop for the faculty members of different colleges under Calcutta University. The main issues discussed in the workshop covered future method of teaching, norms of setting question papers and other aspects of the new syllabus. Participants from more than 80 colleges affiliated to the University participated in the workshop and interacted with members of the Board of Under Graduate Studies for Bengali under Calcutta University.

Name of the course: 'PRACTICAL & CREATIVE WRITING IN BENGALI LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE'.

DURATION: 15 CLASSES EACH OF 2 HOURS.

OBJECTIVES AND AIM OF THE COURSE: The fifth largest spoken language of the world is supposed to be Bangla or Bengali. Many students of the college opt for Bengali Major or Minor in their UG-syllabus, obviously aspiring for jobs in future. And no doubt Bengali has various opportunities in the job-field for future generation. Students pursuing Bengali as a subject can aspire to become a copy editor, proof reader, DTP operator or can work as a journalist apart from pursuing their career in teaching. In fact they can become creative writers, translators or can become content writers and copy writers.

But like various other languages of the world Bengali too has certain typical problems and nuances which are faced by the users of this language. Particularly the complicated rules of the Bengali language's spellings and scripts often act as an obstacle for the users. Keping all these problems that are faced by the students, the Bengali Department of the college framed a coursework for total 30 hours comprising 15 classes, each of 2 hours duration over the above mentioned period. 30 students participated in these Add on Coursework by paying a meager fee of Rs. 300/-. The detailed framework of the coursework is given below along with few photographs taken during the progress of the coursework. The classes were taken by eminent personalities and professors.






6. STUDENT'S FRESHER'S WELCOME AND FAREWELL PROGRAMMES:


10. DEPARTMENTAL REUNION:
