

Departmental Meeting held on 30th July, 2024

The Department of Economics held a meeting on 30th July at 12 noon in the staff room. It was presided over by the Head of the Department, Prof Sudeshna Mitra and attended by all the four faculty members. The following agenda were discussed in the meeting.

Agenda :

The HOD announced that the classes for the new session will begin from 6th August, 2024 and orientation programme of the college for new students of SEM 1 would be held on that day itself. She discussed the syllabus pattern for SEM1.

SEM1

For SEM1 (Major), ECOM, there will be two papers – DSCC1 and SEC1 and for Minor and MDC there are two papers also – CC1/MN1 and SEC papers. This year IDC (ECO) will not be there in SEM1. Moreover syllabus of DSCC1 and CC of MDC/Minor is same. The SEC paper for Major would be Statistics (Basic) and SEC-MDC will be Data Analysis and Report writing/Entrepreneurship and Development (Ref: Bhadra and Satpathi). Question setting and Evaluation would be done internally for IDC and MDC-SEC. It was decided after discussion between faculty members that this year, 2024-2025, Entrepreneurship and Development will be offered as MDC-SEC paper.

Minor : Paper CC1 (Micro) – IB & SMI

MDC : Paper MDC3 (Development) – IB & SMI

MDC Minor : Microeconomics

The department will try to approach different academic institutions/organizations/companies for Internship. The last option that was discussed was to do a Research Paper based on primary data or secondary data.
