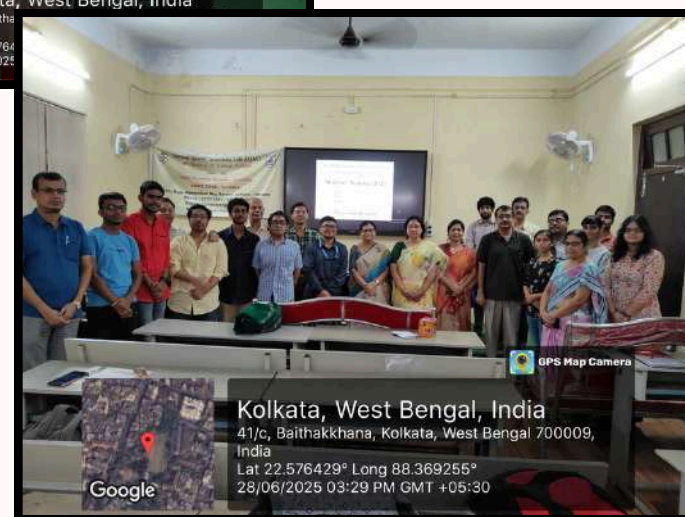


Students' Seminar
