- Comment on the philosophical and stylistic approach of Francis Bacon with reference to 'Of Studies'.
- 3. Discuss how George Orwell's 'Shooting an Elephant' addresses the question of identity.
- 4. Briefly discuss the importance of 'children' in 'Dream Children: A Reverie'.
- Critically discuss how James Joyce transforms the setting of the short story 'Araby' into a 'symbol'.
- 6. Do you think Jhumpa Lahiri's 'A Temporary Matter' can be read as a culmination of personal relationship? Discuss with reference to the story.
- 7. Write a short note on Joyce's narrative technique in 'Araby'.
- 8. Comment on the major developments in English prose writing during the Renaissance.
- 9. How would you define the term 'modern short story'? Discuss with reference to texts of your choice.
- 10. How would you define modern prose? Discuss with reference to any three writers of your choice.
