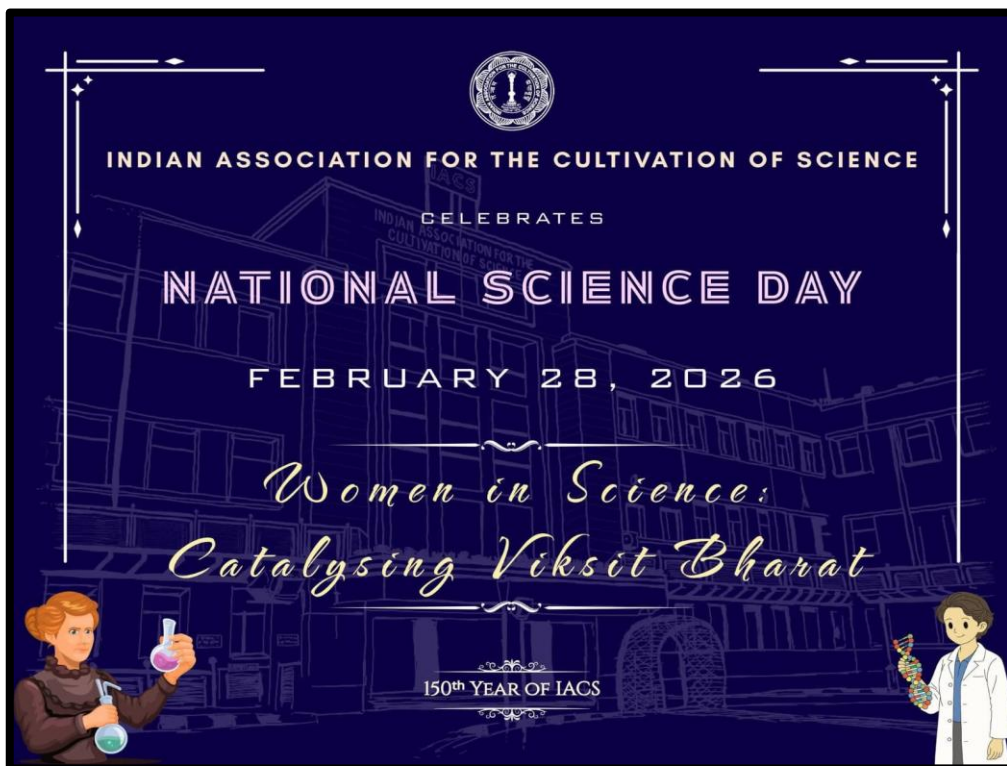
Introductory Remark

Finally, I cordially wish every success in their future endeavours.

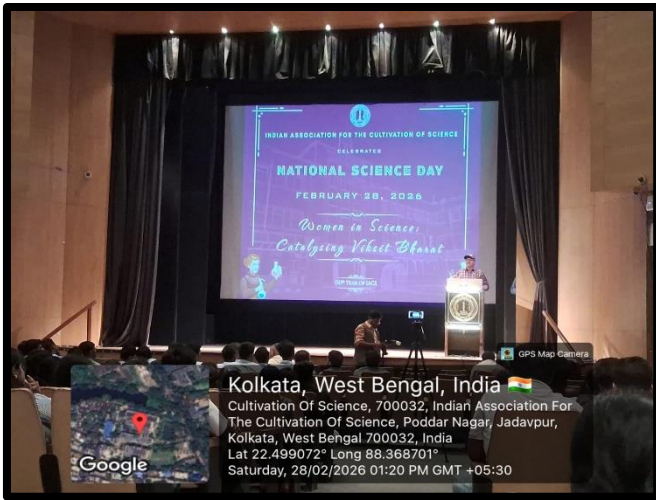

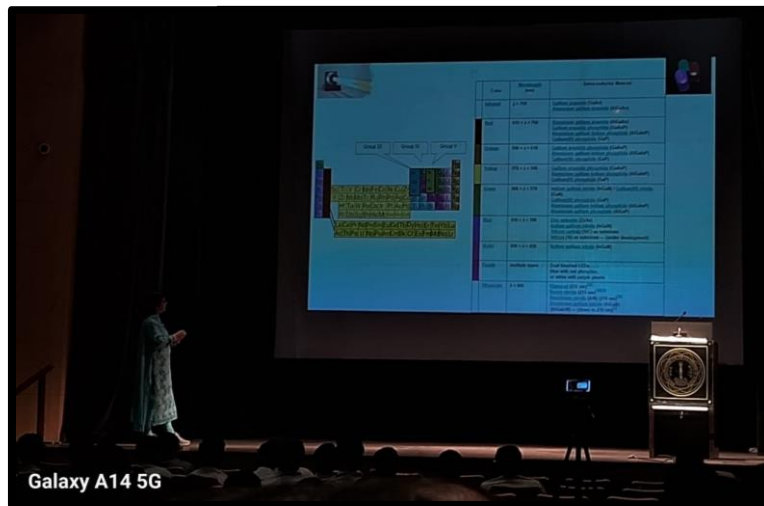

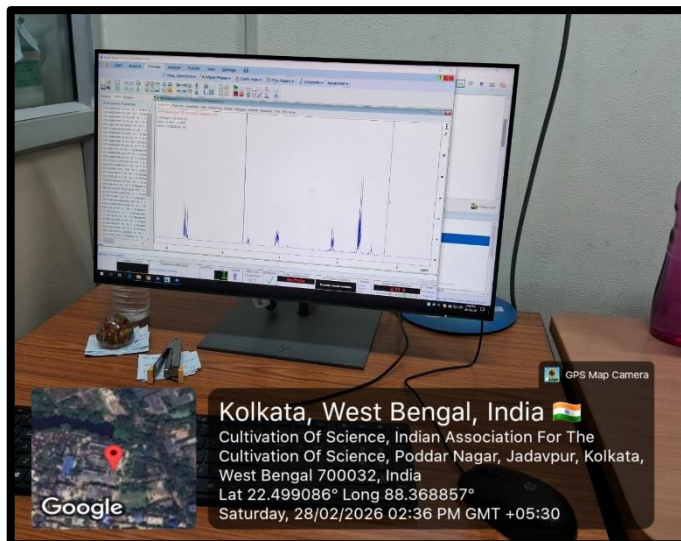

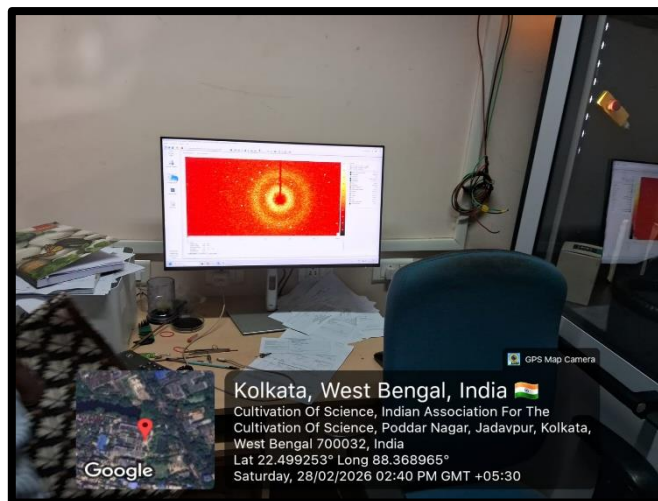

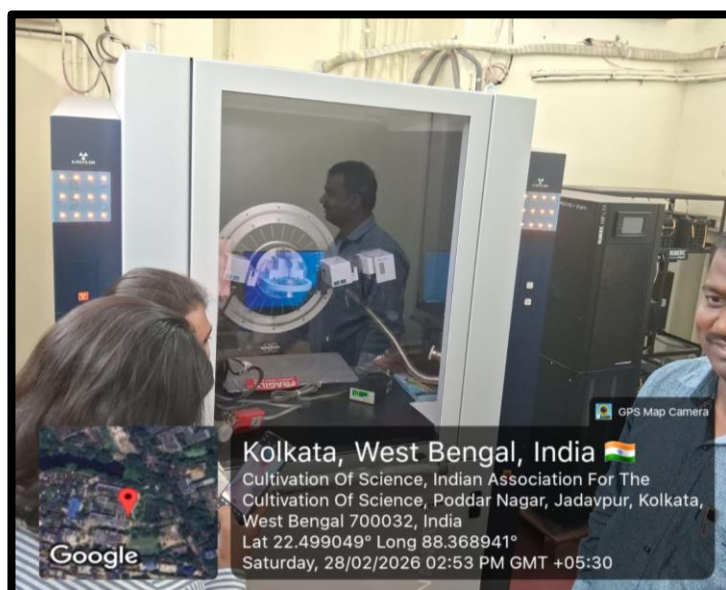

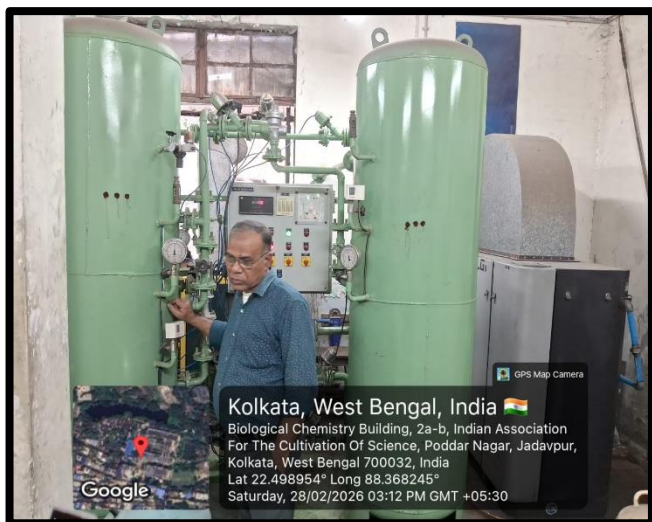
Single Crystal X-Ray Diffractometer
