

Report on an Essay Writing Competition on Netaji and visit to Netaji Bhaban held on January 23, 2026 and February 20, 2026

The Department of Political Science organised an Essay Writing Competition on Netaji's contribution to India's freedom struggle on his 129th Birth Anniversary on 23rd January 2026. This was followed up by a visit to Netaji Bhawan on 20th February on Elgin road for an experiential learning exercise.

This active learning method enabled them to have a holistic understanding of Netaji by providing an engaging, hands-on experience that encouraged them to critically analyze and reflect what they have read in their books.

This two part programme had been geared to create an interest amongst students to continue reading, learning and engaging themselves with national leaders and their political philosophies.

28 students of Semester 1, 3 and 5 attended the visit.
