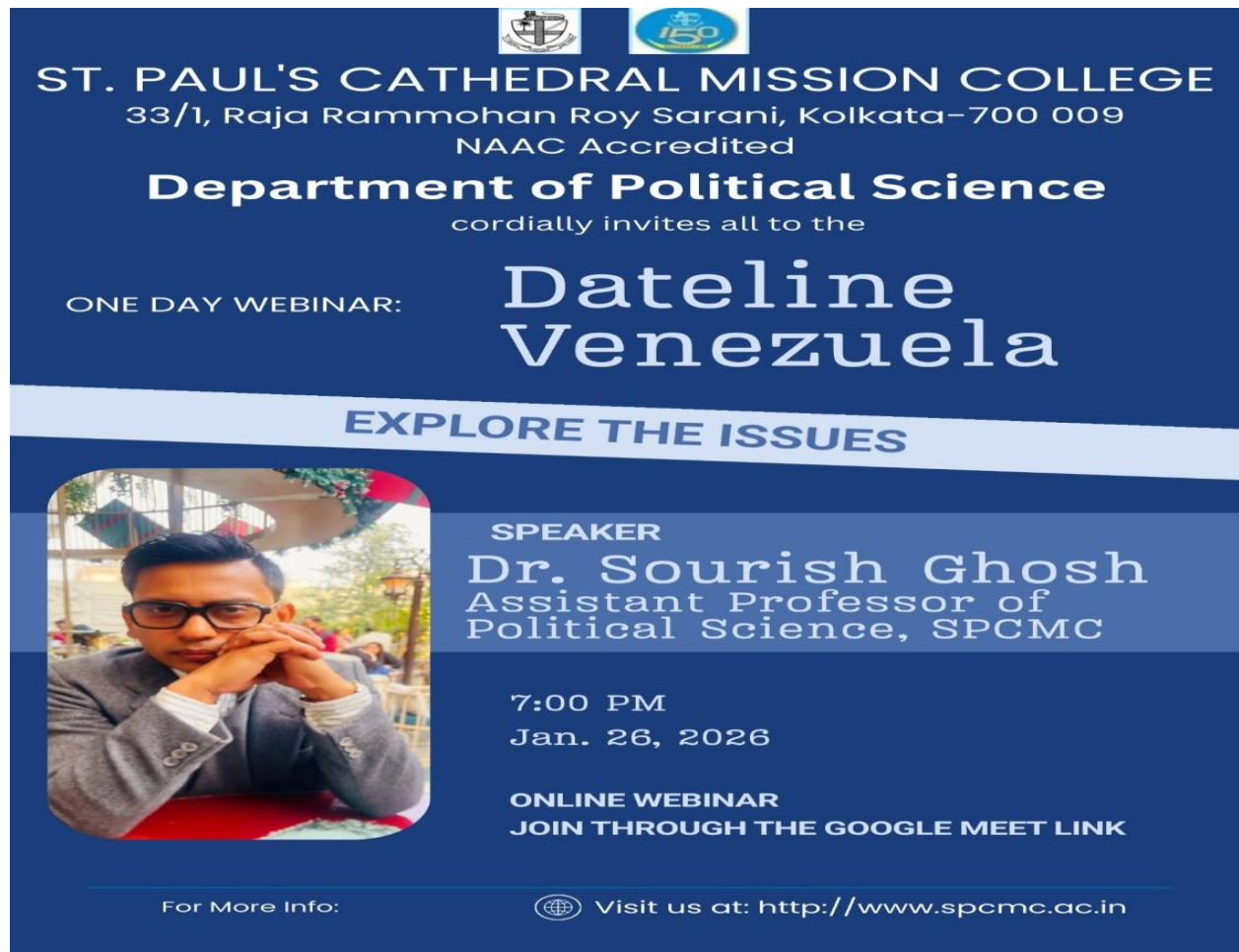


Report on Commemorating the Republic Day of India held on January 26, 2026

To commemorate the Republic Day of India on 26th January, two special lectures were lined up for the students. An online discussion on India's Transition from Dominion to Republic was led by Mr. Kushal Chakrabarty. He analyzed the history behind this date being chosen and elaborated on the celebrations around this day annually.

An evening lecture titled, Dateline Venezuela was delivered by Dr Sourish Ghosh who traced the conflict in Venezuela and linked it with the international developments gripping the 21st Century focusing on the geopolitical permutations and combinations centered on control of oil resources worldwide.

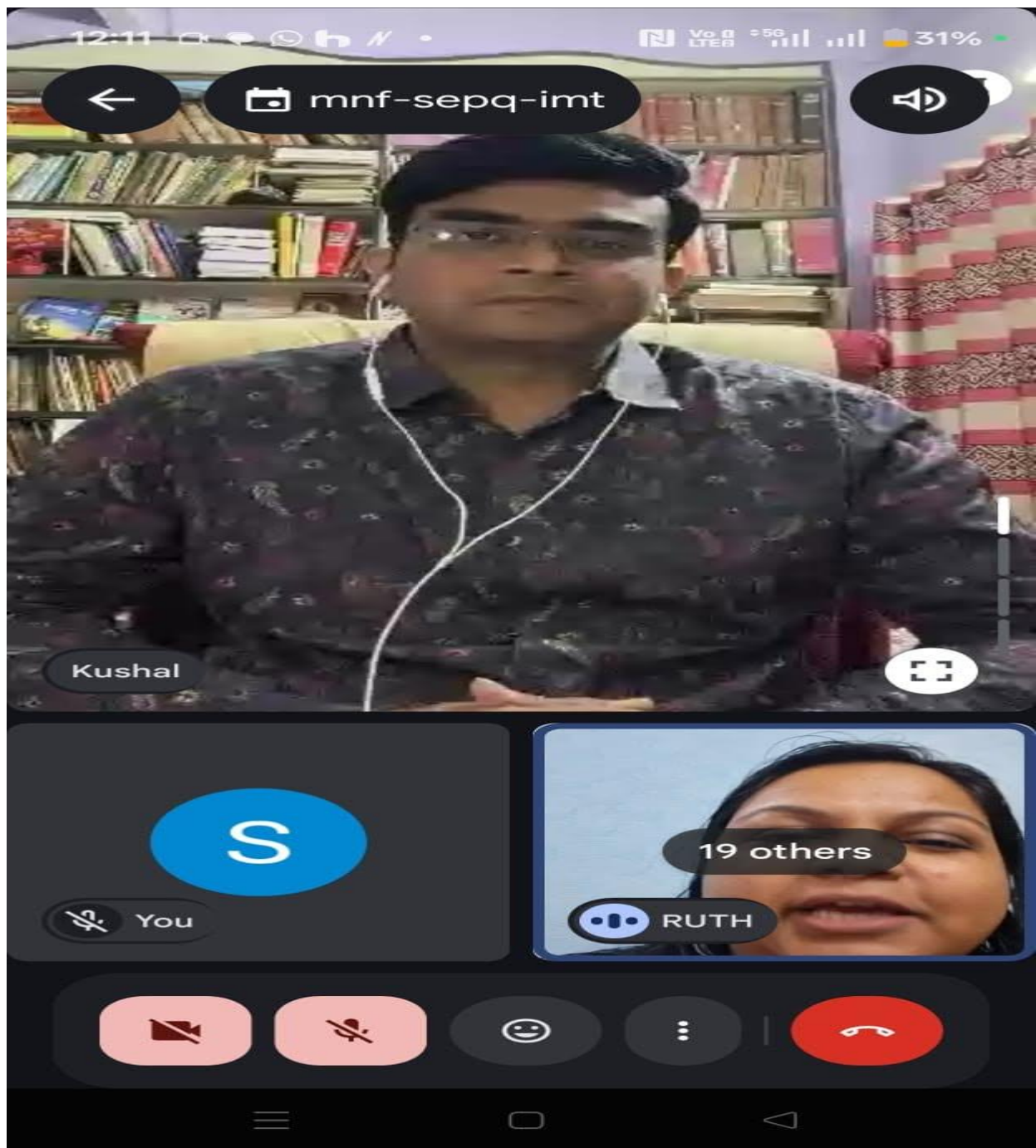
